Tender Response Information

Tender responses must contain:

- Location areas to which your tender relates;
- Cost per student in class;
- Cost per student in car;
- A chronological resuming containing: work experience, education related to Driver Instructing, contact information including phone number, mailing address, and email, and at least two (2) references that can be contacted and would be able to speak to your experience as a Driver Instructor;
- A recent criminal record and vulnerable sector check (completed within 3 months of your Tender submission);
- A valid Driver Training School Certificate from SGI;
- A copy of your Liability Insurance; and
- A copy of your Licence Bond.



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Contractors may submit tenders on any or all area locations for either a one or two-year term. Using the information provided, the Director of Education (or designate) will evaluate all tenders and award the successful contractors as they see fit.

PART TWO: Conditions of Driver Education Services

Instruction and Services

The Contractor shall follow the Driver Education Program that is issued by SGI/The Ministry of Education (“the Driver Education Program”) and, until changed by SGI/The Ministry of Education shall consist of:

1. a minimum of thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction, provided the students are not enrolled in a course that is being streamed over the internet; and
2. six (6) hours of in-car-behind-the-wheel instruction. Such instruction shall include a variety of in-car experiences; that is gravel roads, highways, and in urban centers.

Classes

Confirmation of the class size, length, time, and dates shall be determined by the Contractor in conjunction with and subject to the final approval of the Principal of each school. In the event that an acceptable schedule cannot be arranged, the Contractor shall contact the Director of Education (or designate).

Role of the School Principal

The Principal of each school shall supervise the program in order to ensure adherence to the terms and conditions of this Agreement



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Enrollment and Eligibility of Students

The Contractor agrees to provide the Driver Education Program to all students who are eligible as per Division policy, and have enrolled in the program.

Supply and Standard of Vehicles

The Contractor will license and supply a dual controlled driver training vehicle(s), and all equipment, including any equipment required for in-car-behind-the-wheel instruction, which must meet or exceed any minimum standards set out in the regulations made pursuant to *The Traffic Safety Act*. The Contractor shall assume all costs relating to the purchase, maintenance, repair, inspection, operation and licensing of the Driver Training Vehicle.

Payment and Invoicing

Payment will be provided monthly at a value of 75% of estimated costs averaged over nine (9) months from September to May. This estimated cost will be based on fees and enrollment as determined by The Contractor in conjunction with the Director of Education (or designate).

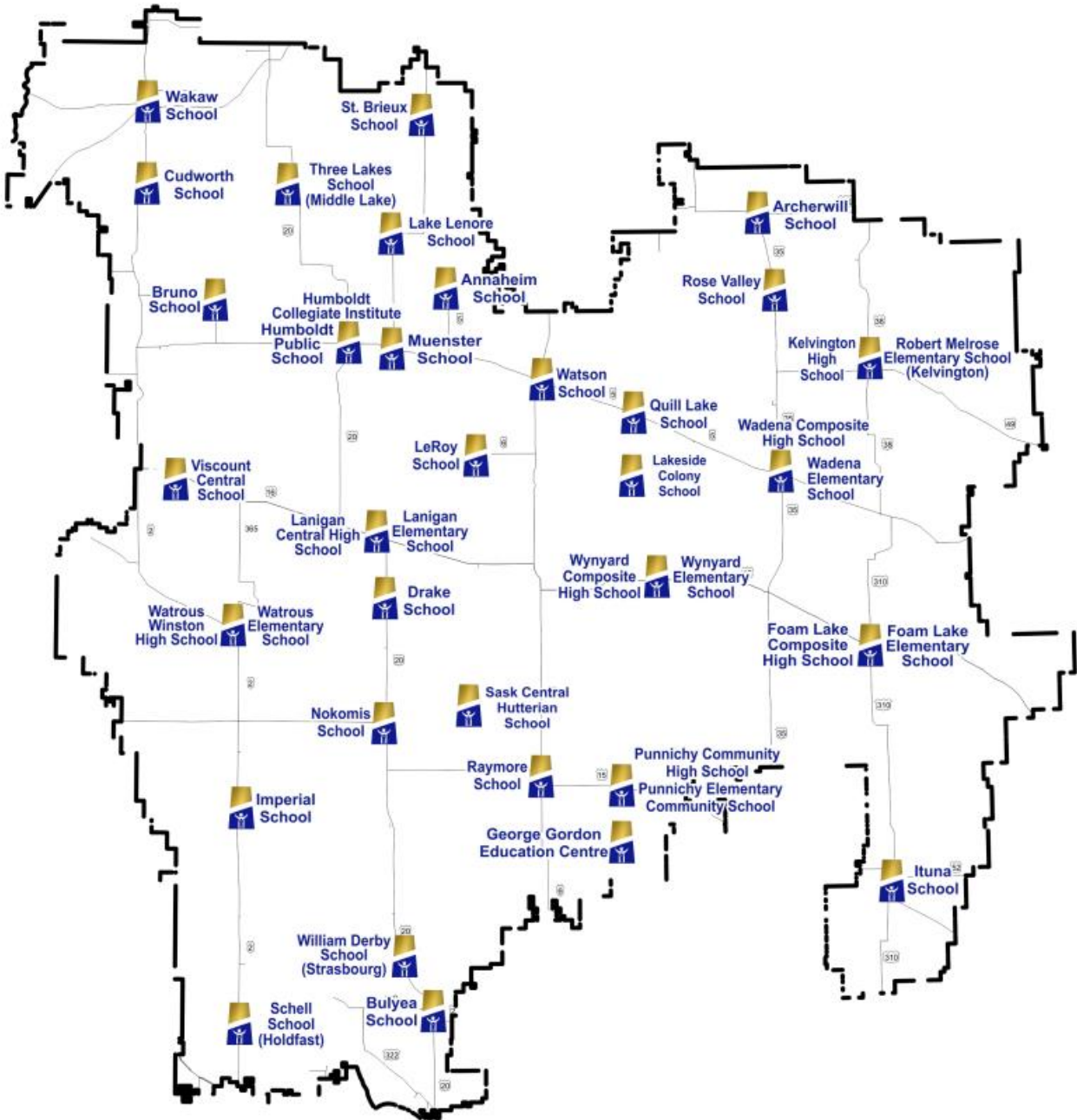
The Contractor shall submit program completion and attendance records, signed by the Principal, together with a final invoice for payment, including any adjustments necessitated by student discontinuance. Following receipt of all documentation and verification that all relevant information has been uploaded into the SGI AutoFunds portal, final payment may be expected within thirty (30) days.
